- 9. 6 Main Reasons We Plant Trees for Salmon
 - A. Roots hold <u>dirt</u>, preventing erosion which can the smother the <u>redds</u> within the stream.
 - B. Large woody debris create log jams that provide **resting** spots,

<u>feeding</u> areas , and <u>hiding</u> spaces from predators.

- C. Trees provide **shade**, keeping stream temperatures **low**, a necessity for the survival of salmon.
- D. Trees provide **Oxygen**.
- E. Trees provide food and habitat for **bugs**, which are food for **juvenile** salmon.
- F. Trees use the carbon in CO2 as building blocks to grow, thus becoming **Carbon reservoirs.**
- 10. Native plant: A species that **originates** in a given region.
